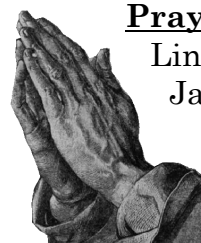
October Rosary will be said on Thursdays at 3:30PM at home of Teresa Gallaher on 7th & Walker, Apt #1. All are welcome.
