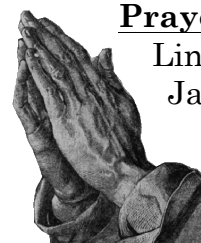
October Rosary will be said on Thursdays at 3:30PM at home of Teresa Gallaher on 7th & Walker, Apt #1. All are welcome.

Rosary: You have probably heard the story about Mary revealing the Rosary to St. Dominic in the 12th century. St. Dominic did pray and teach a form of the Rosary, and may have had some kind of miraculous confirmation that the prayer was a powerful one. At the same time, historians note that the prayer developed over centuries. It originated in the Divine Office or Liturgy of the Hours. Priests and religious pray the Divine office daily. At its core, it is a recitation of the 150 Psalms with antiphons, readings, and prayers. Lay people, who in the Middle Ages were often illiterate, wanted to join priests and religious in this prayer. Gradually, a simplified version that could be easily memorized was created. Before Pope John Paul II added the Luminous Mysteries, the full Rosary contained 150 Hail Marys. Like the Divine Office, each set of prayers ends in a Glory Be.
