During Lent, our parish will hold Vespers (Evening prayers).

The Lenten Vesper Service is a beautiful tradition that is essentially a prayer service sung or chanted. The Vespers service is meant to remind us of the Old Testament period, the creation of the world, leading to the hope of mankind in accordance with the promise of God for a Savior and ending with the fulfillment of that promise. **We will pray on Mondays during Lent at 5:40pm. Please join us!**



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on **fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59**. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning **abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards**.
